## Contest Instructions

November 29-30, 2025

### Tech Info

- Contest Control System: **DOMjudge**;
- Judge Environments: **Ubuntu 24.04.03 LTS** ;
- Allowed languages: **C, C++, Java, Kotlin, Python3**;
- The size of the submitted source code must not exceed **256 KiB**;
- Additional technical information can be found at *Applications > Contest > Technical Notes*.

### Compilation Args

#### C (GCC 13.3.0)

```
gcc -x c -Wall -std=gnu11 -O2 -fmax-errors=3 -static -pipe -o "$DEST" "$@" -lm
```

#### C++ (G++ 13.3.0)

```
g++ -x c++ -Wall -std=gnu++20 -O2 -fmax-errors=3 -static -pipe -o "$DEST" "$@"
```

#### Java (OpenJDK 17.0.8)

```
javac -encoding UTF-8 -sourcepath . -d . "$@"
```

#### Kotlin (Version 1.9.24)

```
kotlinc -d . "$@"
```

#### Python 3 (Python 3.9.15, Pypy 7.3.10)

```
pypy3 -m py_compile "$@"
```

### Submit Code

- You can use  **Submit** button to submit your code;
- To submit from the command line, see `submit --help` for details;
- If the files are named correctly (e.g. A.cpp, B.py, etc.), the problem code and language will be automatically recognized;
- Any behavior that is deemed an activity detrimental to the contest may result in disqualification, determined by the staff.

### Clarifications

- To request clarification, use **Clarifications** button;
- **Please do not post code in your clarification request!**

### Print Code

- You can upload your source code file in **Print** page;
- To print from the command line, see `printfile --help` for detail;
- The single printing task limit is **5 pages** A4 paper, the excess will not be printed;
- Please do not submit non-text documents(such as ZIP, PDF).

## Judging Result

A detailed judging notes can be found at *Applications > Contest > Judging Notes*.

- **CORRECT**: Your submission is correct, congratulations!
- **WRONG-ANSWER**: Your program output a wrong answer (or did not match the judges' output within the specified tolerance), including output nothing or output limit exceeded.
- **RUN-ERROR**: Your program crashed before completing. There may be many causes for this, including but not limited to division by zero, subscript out of bounds, out of memory, etc.
- **TIMELIMIT**: Your program ran for too long on at least one test case.
- **COMPILER-ERROR**: Your submission was never run because it did not compile. You can click to view details.

It is recommended to output strictly according to the output format described in the problem statements, and there should be **NO** results like **presentation errors**.

The problem set may include one or more *interactive problems*. See additional notes on interactive problems in the detailed judging notes.
