# COMP 1991: General Information

- Required course for:
  - COMP program
  - COMP + BBA dual degree program
  - Big Data Minor program
- COMP: automatically registered from year 2 spring semester
- COMP + BBA: automatically registered from year 3 spring semester
- Big Data Minor students:
  - have to enroll in SIS themselves for the first time or when you resume study from leave
  - would be automatically enrolled in the future
- PP ("permitted to proceed") grade until satisfying all requirements

# COMP 1991: Course Requirements

Two ways of fulfilling requirements:

## ① Internships

- Strongly preferred
- Work must be related to computer science / information technology
- Minimum period of six weeks (two internships at two companies for a total period of at least six weeks acceptable)
- Full-time
- Off-campus

## ② Industrial Training Modules

- Not as desirable as internships
- Students unable to find internships will do three industrial training modules during year 4 winter.

# Benefits of an Internship

- Gain real-world work experience
- Explore career possibilities
- Hone your soft skills (communication, teamwork)
- Learn about your strengths and weaknesses
- Become more confident and mature
- Looks good on your resume and will help you get a **job** when you graduate

# Types of Internships

- Paid or unpaid
- Local, mainland, or overseas
- Duration:
  - Minimum six weeks
  - Summer internships from June to August are most common
  - Winter internships from late December to end of January
  - Longer internships are strongly encouraged (need to apply for study leave)
    - 6-8 months (June to January)
    - 12-15 months (June to next August)

# Using Internship to fulfill COMP 1991 Requirements

## COMP / COMP + BBA students

- All paperwork on e-advising website
- By year 2, students should prepare and submit CV
- **At least two weeks** before starting internship, submit the following for **provisional approval** by Internship Coordinator:
  - Online application + Offer letter + Job description details
- **Within two weeks** on completing internship, submit the following for **final approval** by Internship Coordinator:
  - Supervisor feedback form + Internship report + Student survey
- Email cseintn@cse.ust.hk to seek approval (internship application/final approval)

## Big Data Minor students

- submit the **same documents** as other students except that they would do everything **offline**
- Hilda Chan will send the detail steps to the Big Data Minor students when they are enrolled to the minor

# New Co-Op Program

- a new program for CSE/CPEG/ECE
- allows you to work on your FYP in a company setting

## Highlights

- You work **FULL-TIME** as an intern in a company for at least 5 months (which may start around Sep 2020 or Jan 2021)
- Your job duty is mainly working on a project that is a **REPLACEMENT** of your FYP and Industrial Experience requirements
- You gain valuable working experience
- You work under the guidance of an industrial supervisor

## Note

- Since you are working full-time for a few months, you will need to arrange your course work to make room for that
  - you should have a **relatively light remaining course workload**
